Marigold	Fall (Seeds)	Full - Sun	2 feet, dwarfs 6-12 Inches	Yellows, oranges, reds	Spring to Frost
Petunia	April (Plants)	Sun	8-24 Inches	Purples, reds, whites, many others	Spring to Frost
Zinnia	Fall (Seeds)	Fall Sun	6-18 Inches	Bright Oranges, reds, yellows, and other sun colors	Spring to Frost
Ageratum	April (Plants)	Sun	6-20 Inches	Blues, pinks, white	July to Frost
Alyssum	Spring or Fall (Seeds)	Sun or Shade	2-4 Inches	Usually white but also rose, dark violet	Summer
Strawflowers	November To march	Sun	12-18 Inches	Purple, red, gold or white	July to Frost
Portulaca	Fall or Spring (Seeds)	Sun	6-9 Inches	Pink, reed, white, yellow, salmon, rose	Late June to Frost
Celosia or Cockscomb	April (Plants)	Sun	6-36 inches	Red or yellow	July to Frost
Stock	September or Springs (Seeds)	Sun	24-30 Inches	Red, pink, white, blue, or yellow	Spring
Calendula	Fall or early Spring (Plants)	Sun	24 Inches	Yellow, orange	April to Frost
Impatiens	Spring and Fall (Seeds or Plants)	Shade	6-15 Inches	White, red, rose, pink, orange and yellow	June to Frost
Pansy	Fall (Seeds) Spring (Plants)	Sun	6-10 Inches	Blues, purples, yellows, and reds	Late winter, April-May
Begonia	Spring (Seeds or Plants)	Shade	8-10 Inches	White, pink to red	June to Frost
Coleus	April (Plants)	Shade	20-24 Inches	Follage of reds, greens, and white in striking patterns	Spring to Frost
Snapdragons	Spring (Seeds)	Sun or light shade	10-36 Inches	Yellows, salmon, oranges, reds, many other colors	Spring and early Summer
Sweet Peas	November to March (Seeds)	Sun	Vine	Pastel lavenders, pinks, yellows and others	Late winter, April- May
